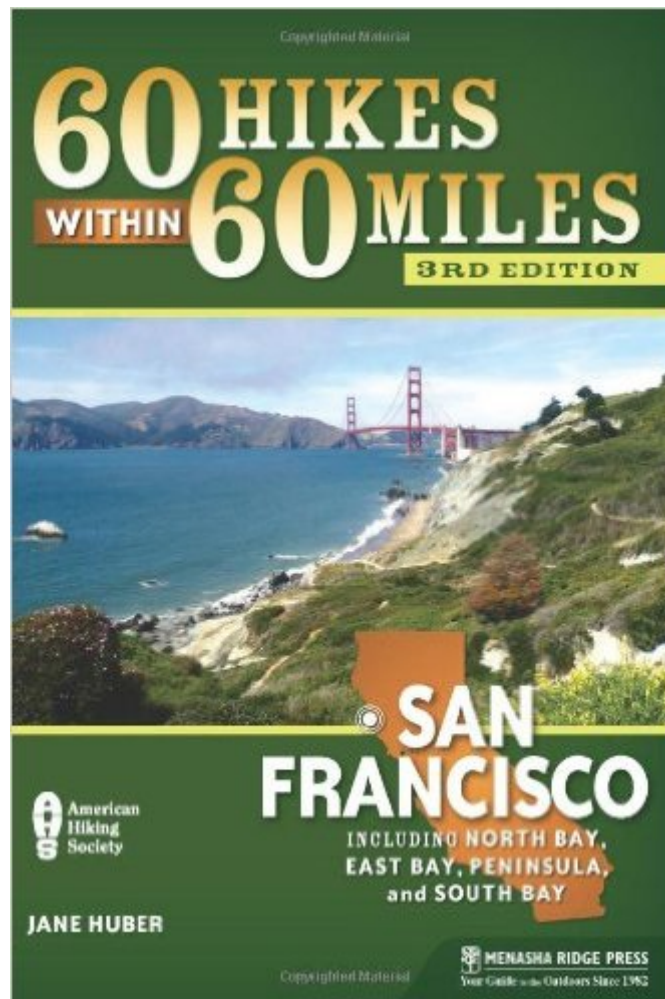

Though the guide does not cover every trail in each park, it highlights a trail that is representative of what's available at that park or location. I photocopy just the few pages of the book that relate to a particular trail instead of carrying the entire book with me on a hike. I look forward to exploring all 60 hikes !
